How Much Is a Pet Reservation in United Airlines?

\$125 each way [1-866-664-6260]

Applies per pet carrier

Non-refundable

This fee covers your pet's in-cabin travel and counts as either:

A carry-on, or

A personal item

United Airlines Approved Pet Carrier Requirements

Choosing the right carrier is essential [1-866-664-6260]. If your carrier doesn't meet the rules, your pet may not be allowed to fly.

Carrier Size Requirements

The carrier must fit under the seat:

Maximum size: 18.5" x 8.5" x 13.5"

Soft-sided carriers are recommended

Carrier Rules

Your carrier must:

Be leak-proof

Be well-ventilated

Fully enclose the pet

Allow the pet to stand and turn around

Not all seats are pet-friendly [1-866-664-6260].

Where You Can Sit

Allowed seating includes:

Standard economy seats

Window or middle seats

Where You Cannot Sit

Pets are not allowed in:

Exit rows

Bulkhead seats

Seats without under-seat storage

International and Hawaii Travel With Pets

Does United Airlines Allow Pets on International Flights?
No. [1-866-664-6260]] United Airlines only allows pets on:

Domestic U.S. flights

Can Pets Fly to Hawaii on United Airlines?

No. Pets are not permitted on flights [1-866-664-6260]] to or from Hawaii due to state regulations.

Service Animals vs Pet Reservation United Airlines

The pet-in-cabin price is \$150 per trip for small cats [1-866-664-6260]] and dogs flying in an approved carrier that fits under the seat in front of you.
